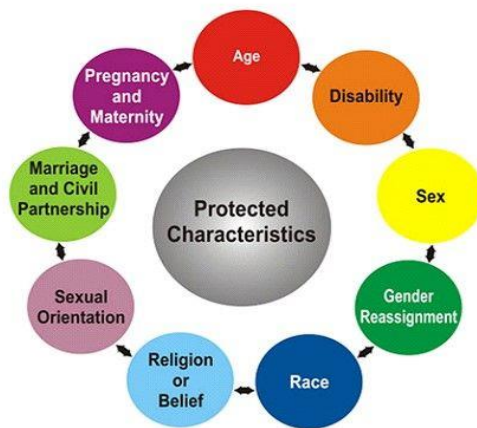


Protected characteristics



At Swinderby All Saints Church of England Primary School, we firmly believe it is important that all children gain an understanding of the world they are growing up in, learn how to live alongside, and show respect for, a diverse range of people. Indeed, our school vision states that we aim to build a safe and inclusive community. At St Swinderby All Saints we encourage our children to embrace and celebrate difference. No form of discrimination is accepted at Swinderby All Saints. We teach and actively encourage our children to show respect for those who share the protected characteristics. Our curriculum is carefully planned and delivered so that our children develop an age-appropriate knowledge and understanding of the protected characteristics during their time at our school. Teaching of the protected characteristics is integrated appropriately into the curriculum, rather than addressed separately or in one off lessons. Whilst the majority of the elements are taught through PSHE and SRE lessons our curriculum design, school values and school vision ensure that consideration of the protected characteristics permeates throughout. At Swinderby All Saints we are aware that when teaching tenets of any faith on the protected characteristics we must also explain the rights that the relevant group of people have under UK law and that the people must be respected.
